Mulch vs. Compost



Mulch helps conserve water by reducing evaporation, allowing water to be held in the soil for longer. It is used on the top layer of the soil to control weeds, retain moisture and regulate temperature.

Compost is used beneath the top layer of the soil to benefit the soil itself in providing essential nutrients.

Mulch & Compost Giveaway—October 19th—8:00 am to 11:00am

Drop by **Chino Basin Water Conservation District's site at 4594 San Bernardino St. Montclair, CA 91763** to get mulch and compost. This is a self-serve, drive-in event, so bring your own tools, masks, and bins.

Participants are limited to 60 gallons of compost and 120 gallons of mulch. This equates to (2) 30 gallon plastic trash cans (full) for compost and (4) 30 gallon plastic trash cans (full) for mulch.

The compost is donated by the Inland Empire Regional Composting Authority (IERCA), manufacturers of SoilPro Premium Compost Products.

The mulch available is donated by Green Army in Montclair and is a mix of ground local green waste (yard waste and tree trimmings). This blend of mulch contributes to improving soil more than store bought bark or dyed mulch.
